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Talking about Young Teachers Being as Class Teachers and



Cultivating Students' Professional Interest

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Abstract: Under the background of the rapid development of China's higher education, the class teachers are mostly young teachers with higher education level. How young teachers use their knowledge and ability to do a good job as class teachers is the focus of the school and teachers. This paper analyzes the advantages of young teachers, discusses the support provided by colleges and universities from various angles, and expounds the key points of young teachers' strategies to cultivate students' professional interest, with a view to providing some good suggestions.

3.2 The work of the class teacher must have the support of the school system and teachers.

As ordinary people, young teachers are under great pressure, not only from the social survival pressure but also from the psychological pressure of scientific research and academic research. Therefore, it is necessary to establish an incentive mechanism in line with the actual situation and guide young teachers to arrange teaching time and energy reasonably, so as to accomplish teaching tasks better. At the same time, the relevant school system can not quantify the work results, and can not subtract the teacher's work, so as not to affect the work of the class teacher. Colleagues should try their best to provide young teachers with information resources about themselves and the school, and jointly assist young teachers in class counselling. The young teacher is new and unfamiliar with the school situation. Students' needs are diverse, and young teachers must also need the assistance of other teachers.

3.3 Young teachers should be prepared to be dedicated and responsible for the work of the class head teacher.

Young teachers should realize the difference between class management and scientific research. Scientific research can be evaluated by special topics, papers and other forms, and the results of scientific research can be quantified and compared. In class management, there are no specific standards and no direct economic benefits. Young teachers should change from a scientific research role to student workers. Young teachers should have an inner psychological preparation to do a good job as class teachers. First of all, be willing to help students from the bottom of my heart, be willing to serve them, and arouse their interest in learning. And talent training is one of the functions of the school. We should not be partial because of our work performance. We should have the psychological consciousness that since we are employed as class teachers, we should contribute to this position.

4. Strategies for Cultivating Students' Professional Interest

At present, the biggest problem for students is the lack of professional interest, which leads to bad habits such as lazy study, playful play and idleness. Once a bad habit is formed, it is hard to change it without experiencing great setbacks. Therefore, at the initial stage of students' school study, it is necessary to cultivate students' interest in their major and discipline. Under this background, teachers should actively do a good job as class teachers, and strengthen the guidance of students' professional interests and study.

4.1 Organizing interest groups and encouraging participation in competitions

At present, students' active learning motivation is insufficient, both because the basic courses are biased towards theory and because they have not fully found their own interests. As the saying goes, the best teacher is interested. While observing students' passive learning, we also realize that many students have a desire to learn but no professional guidance. In view of this situation, the class teacher can organize interest groups, such as making websites. The goal in the early stage is to realize functions. The deeper the website is built, the better the professional knowledge memory is. In the later stage, various competitions can be held, so that students can better conduct in-depth study and research. By means of group cooperation, students are guided to turn their interest in learning into motivation, and knowledge into ability, so as to realize their own value.

4.2 To guide innovation and promote technology research and development.

Practice is the inevitable requirement of the times and social development. Teachers can provide students with suitable practical projects according to the actual development of their major and industry, and organize interested students to participate. By analyzing the problems raised by the teachers, this paper puts forward and explores the solutions, and carries out technical innovation and research on this basis. In this process, the class teacher plays a guiding role, guiding students on how to think and how solve problems. In addition, students should have a foreseeable short-term goal so that they can not give up halfway in their studies. For example, at a certain stage, students have achieved certain results. Students are taught to prove their achievements in a specific period in the form of papers or patents, so as to motivate them to continuously improve their achievements.

5. Conclusion

Although young teachers have their own strengths, they still need the efforts of schools, colleges and other aspects. As a class teacher, you should set an example and be a model in class management, strengthen self-cultivation and improve educational ability. At the same time, young teachers should actively think, explore the methods and ways of class management, make contributions to class teaching management, and cultivate students' interest in majors, thus laying a good foundation for future work.
